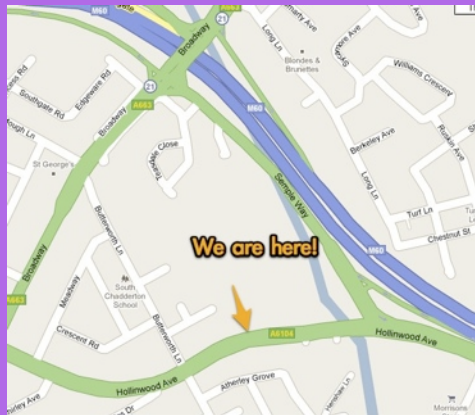
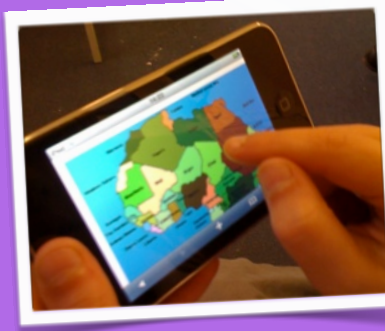

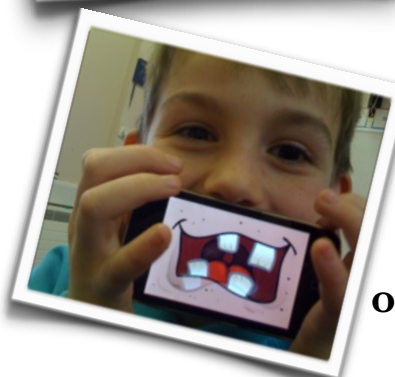

iPod 2010

22nd February

iPod2010 is a symposium for practitioners using iPod Touches or iPhones in education. The event will bring together those people already working on the use of iPods in learning at any phase of learning, together with those working on iPod App development for education and others to share their experiences and learning.

The day will largely focus on opportunities for people to share their projects - the successes, the pitfalls, the techniques they are developing. There is a small - but growing - number of people working on ways in which the iPod and its apps can be part of transforming learning through the ubiquity and ease of access to ICT that the iPod brings, and the changed learning relationships that this ease can support.



For everyone working in the field - teachers, researchers, school leaders and 'ICT in learning' specialists - this is still very much at an experimental stage with the pupils themselves in the forefront of how these developments might shape up. For us all, however, there are also some practical, technical and pedagogic barriers to be knocked down and some learning to undertake and share, particularly if this work is to have the impact it should on curriculum developments and BSF.
